Leather is a natural product crewed from cowhides and is extremely hard wearing.


At Handel Street Upholsterers the highest level of expertise is used in the selection and manufacturing of its leather seating.

Tips for consumers

HERE are a few handy tips for consumers when buying a new vehicle with leather interiors:

- Make sure that the supplier is approved by the manufacturer. When a non-approved supplier is used, the customer's warranty is placed in jeopardy and the manufacturer's warranty will be null and voided. Sales persons do not inform the consumer of this important piece of information – so ask when purchasing your vehicle.
- Find out if the supplier is compliant with manufacturing standards and complies with the manufacturer's selection criteria. Procedures of manufacturing are not documented and therefore warranties by the manufacturer, and in some cases the dealer, cannot be verified when you use a non-approved supplier.
- Ensure that the leather used in the make-up of the leather interior is compliant with specifications set down by the manufacturer and have been tested. Ask the sales person to provide a test certificate from the supplier.
- Consumers should specify to the salesman that they want full leather. When sub-standard material is used in the make-up of the leather seating, you will notice the following problems occurring:
 - ◆ Fading of the leather within a period of three to six months;
 - ◆ the leather is of an inferior quality and therefore tears at the seams within the first three months of installation;
 - ◆ the leather colour rubs off onto an individual's clothes;
 - ◆ in the event of a cigarette falling onto the seats, it would burn through and damage the seating area. Therefore it could be more of a fire hazard than a comfort or solution;
 - ◆ the general appearance of the interior would deteriorate and look shabby, and installation is of a poor quality.
- Consumers should be given the option of various colours, ranges, colour combinations, logos, etc when customising their new vehicles.
